



## **Soccer Notice 2021**

Dear Parents / Caregivers

St Francis will continue with the North West Junior Soccer Association this year. The season will be commencing on May 8<sup>th</sup> 2021 and will continue through to the end of Term 3.

The age the player turns during the current year is the players age group, e.g. if your child is turning 9 during 2021 they are an Under 9. We do tend to keep players in their Year levels more so then their age levels.

### **COVID 19 Management**

It is great to see soccer back for our school students and we want to make sure we are doing everything right to see that it stays operational. To assist with Covid 19 Management during this playing season all adults that are present on games days must scan in every week by using the QR codes provided at each of the grounds. Please continue to social distance and if you or your child are unwell please stay home.

The NWJSA are waiting for confirmation from SA Health in regards to the need for Covid Marshals for each team. To best prepare ourselves can you please indicate below if you have already done the online training course to become a Covid Marshal and if you would be willing to take on this role for your child's team. Without this position filled each week the games may not be able to proceed and also the NWJSA could be penalized. Unfortunately the team coach or team manager cannot take on this role also.

**GAMES** All Matches for U6-U11 are played at either the West Lakes or St Clair Complex on Saturday mornings. The U12 and Seniors teams will play at the Westport Primary School Grounds

### **COACHES/ MANAGERS/ TEAM STEWARDS**

All teams are coached/supervised by parents. If you feel you can help in this area, please let me know on the return slip of this notice.

**If we do not fill the coaching positions, we cannot field teams.**

It is mandatory that each person assisting in school coaching has a current Police Check Clearance/ DCSI and is a registered volunteer of St Francis School. This is a routine process.

### **PRACTICE**

Training is conducted at the school where possible. Timing of the training sessions is at the discretion of the coaches. You will be informed of coaches and training times as they become available.

### **EQUIPMENT**

Children are required to wear appropriate footwear, shin guards and their school shorts. Mouth guards are worth considering but optional. The students will be supplied with a school soccer top.

### **FEES**

Fees cover, player registration for NWJSA, training and match balls, guernseys, bibs, cones, medical supplies, administrative costs and a trophy, which is presented to the children at the end of the season.

The costs are as follows:

Year R-6 children season fees are \$80 which includes a \$30 deposit required for our guernseys.

**You will be invoiced directly from the school for the season fees. Before your child can be eligible to play school soccer the season fees must be paid in full. Once I have this confirmation that your payment has been received your child will be handed a guernsey to take care of for the season. Once the season has finished all guernseys must be returned before you can receive your \$30 deposit back into your school account.**

**If you wish your child to participate in the 2021 Soccer season, please nominate him/her on the form attached and return this to the school office by no later than Friday 19th March Wk 8. If your child's note is not returned by the due date or before the teams maximum capacity is reached, we may not be able to place him/her into a team unless more numbers are required. More information will be passed on to you as teams are finalized.**

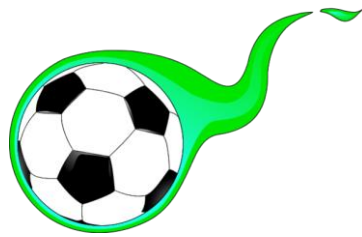
**Please be aware that school soccer will clash with school football so the students will need to decide what sport they wish to play this season**
